



2022 LSAT Diversity & Inclusion Scholarship

The Utah Center for Legal Inclusion (UCLI), with the generous support of the Utah Bar Foundation, is pleased to offer the 2022 LSAT Diversity & Inclusion Scholarship.

PURPOSE

This scholarship is aimed at expanding opportunity for students pursuing legal education who have a strong record of service to Utah's underrepresented communities and commitment to advancing equity and inclusion. College students and recent graduates of undergraduate institutions in the state of Utah planning to take a 2022 or 2023 LSAT exam are invited to apply.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, students must:

- Be an undergraduate student at or recent graduate of any college or university in the state of Utah;
- Be a current member of diverse organizations in and/or out of school;
- Have registered or be committed to registering for an LSAT exam in 2022; and
- Not be receiving assistance for all or part of their LSAT-related expenses from an educational institution or employer.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Awards are selected by a review committee appointed by UCLI. Applications are evaluated on the following:

- Future potential to promote equity and inclusion in Utah's legal profession;
- Demonstrated record of service to Utah's diverse communities;
- Personal qualities and strengths; and
- Financial need.

AWARD

The scholarship helps to offset the expenses of taking and studying for the LSAT exam by reimbursing selected students, up to their reward amount, for qualifying costs associated with the exam. Qualifying costs include the LSAT exam registration fee and the tuition and materials for the University of Utah LSAT Course or another comparable preparatory course.

*Selected students may be reimbursed for additional student aids at the discretion of the review committee.

Fee Waivers

*Fee waivers are not given retroactively, and applications are due at least six weeks prior to test dates.
